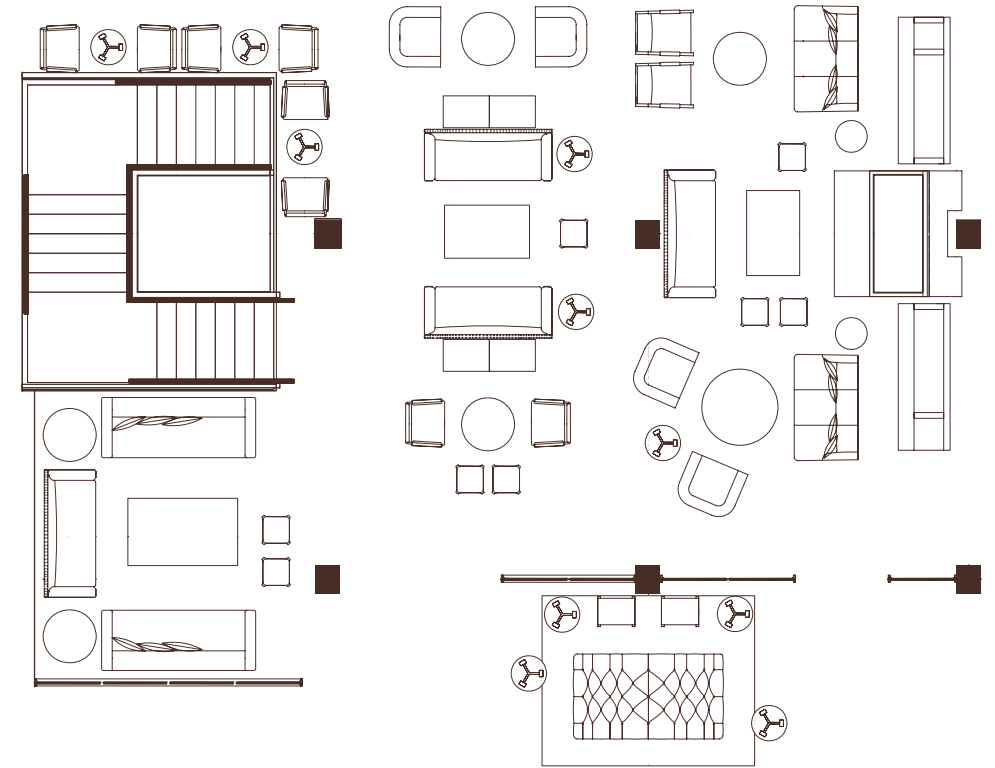
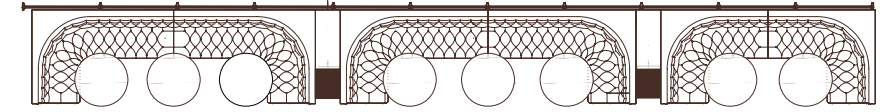

The Lobby

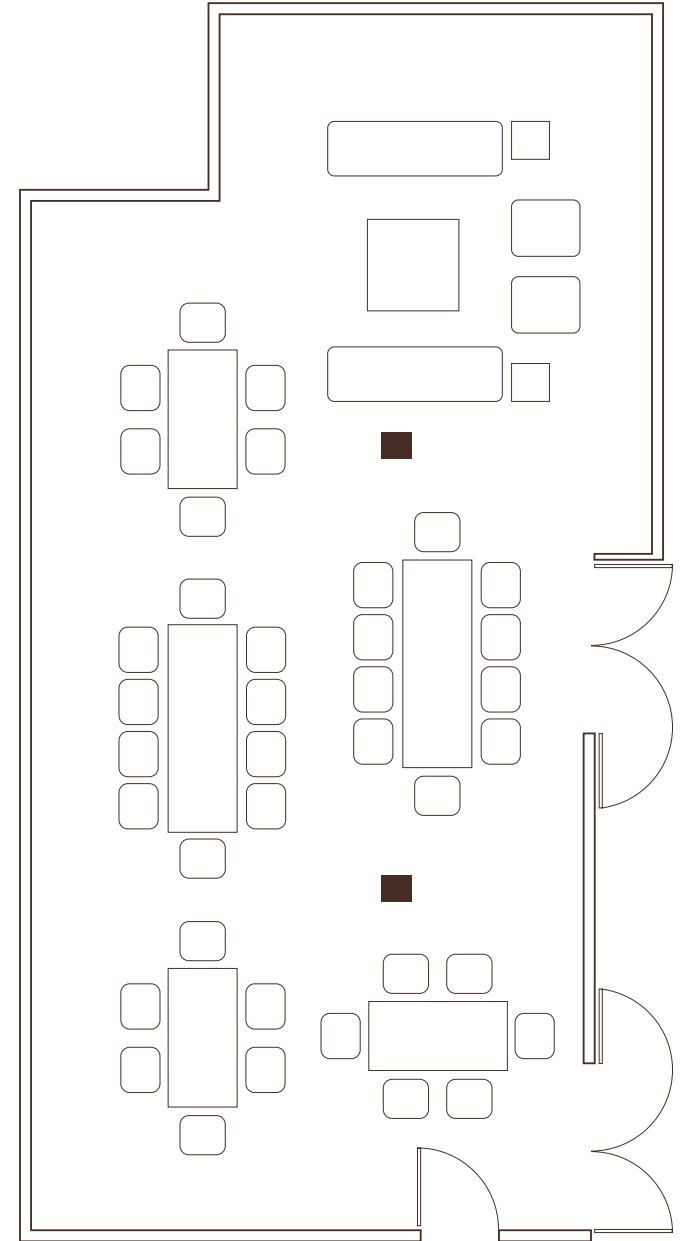

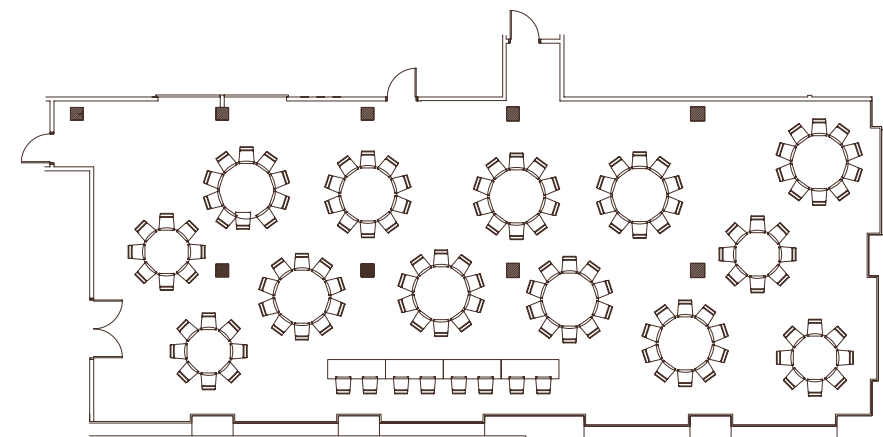
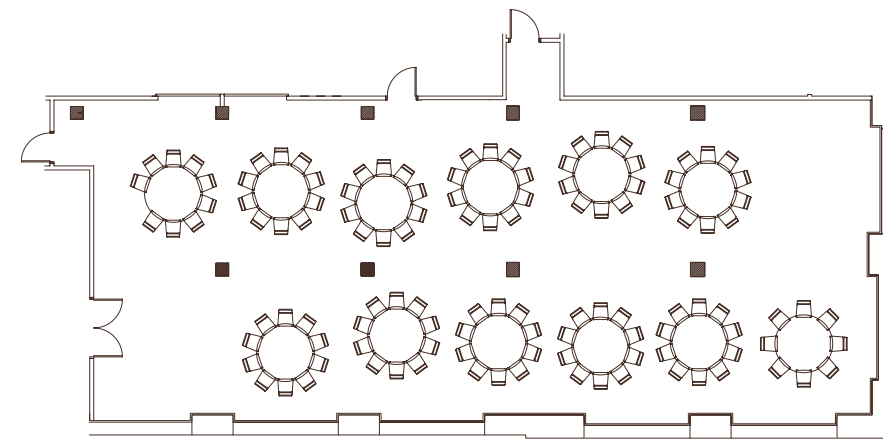




The Library

The Gallery

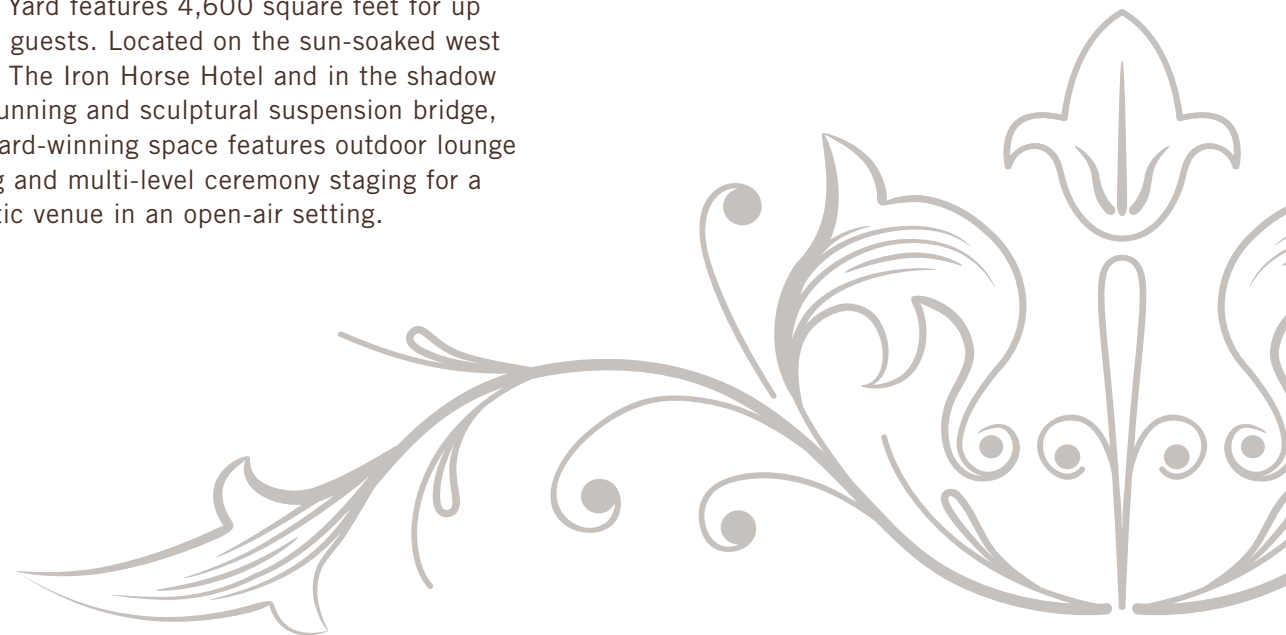

The Yard

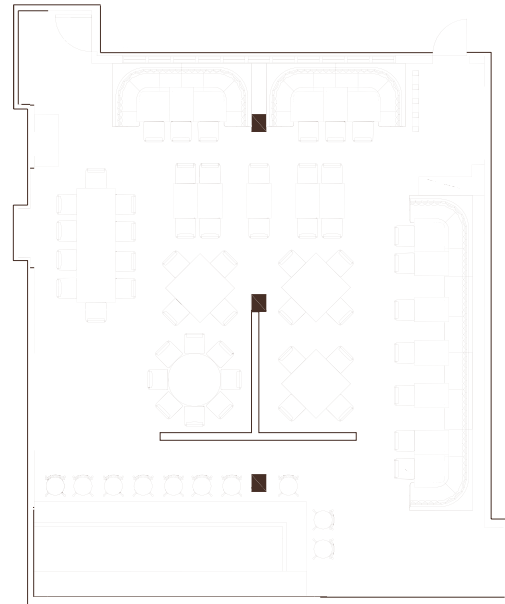
